

Laurel Mountain Elementary
Enrichment Cluster
Grades 2-3 Parent Survey Results

From January 23 to March 13, 2009 we conducted sixteen different second and third grade Enrichment Clusters over a period of eight weeks for 245 students. As part of our efforts to evaluate the success of this program, we asked for all second and third grade parents to give feedback in a survey that was sent in the Monday folder in April 2009. There were 107, or 44%, returned and tallied. We would like to share the results with our parents, teachers and community. Thank you to the parents who took the time to complete and return the survey. We appreciate your efforts since this data is important feedback that we use to help make SEM better at Laurel Mountain.
